GETALONG close up from the start, moved up five wide into the turn, challenged after a half and proved best under pressure. I'VE HEARD IT ALL forwardly placed four wide, challenged after a half and held on gamely. NEED MONEY DAD set the pace, gained the inside midway through the turn, responded willingly in the stretch but was outfinished. COUNT ONE prominent three wide, dropped back a bit once in the turn when attempting to drift out, angled out for the drive and rallied willingly. BULLS FIRST TRICK outrun three wide, angled out for the drive and made a late gain. CUNNINGHAM within striking distance, steadied from between rivals entering the turn, recovered but lacked a late bid. DUBAI AFFAIR forced the pace along the inside and weakened. FOREST PICNIC within reach early, raced six wide into the turn and lacked a closing response. FREE DRINKS within striking distance along the inside, tired. RUNAWAY DIXON seven wide into the turn, was no threat. PAYING THE BILL was outrun.
