SAVAGE VOW tracked the pace three wide, moved up to engage for the lead after a half, edged clear entering the stretch and widened through the final yards. PURE PRIZE GEORGE attended the pace four wide, closed the gap through the second turn, loomed large entering the stretch but was unable to match strides late. UP SYNDROME set the pace along the inside, was collared after a half, disputed the issue to the stretch, but weakened during the drive and was all out to hold the show. LUCKY ALBERT was unhurried into stride, came four wide and improved position through the stretch. DESERT BAY was allowed to settle five wide and failed to threaten. SPOOKY SPIRIT showed little. STORMIN HEDGES failed to respond. ARSHAVIN was hustled along on the inside for a half and dropped out.
