TENDER TOUCH behind the leaders near the rail, angled out four wide leaving the turn when rallying, challenged in upper stretch and drew clear late. MISS CHIEF WOODY alternated for the lead from the start, raced three wide on the turn and held on gamely in the drive. ISN'T SHE GREAT vied for the lead between rivals and weakened late. OCTOBER OPTIMIST outrun early, raced in the four path around the turn and made a late move on the outside. SNAZZY DIVA reserved early, angled out five wide entering the stretch when moving to the leaders then could not be extended in the drive while attempting to bear in. JAMMIN JAVA contested the pace inside rivals, saved ground on the turn and tired in the stretch. BE A QUIET HONEY was outrun while five wide.
