MARIAWORTH reserved early three wide, advanced four wide on the second turn, caught the leader inside the final furlong and edged off late. MARY REBECCA within striking distance along the inside, angled out and moved to challenge three wide entering the stretch, took over in midstretch and held on gamely. SWEET AND RED outrun early along the inside, made a run along the inside entering the stretch but lacked a late bid. UNBRIDLED APPROVAL behind the leaders off the inside, challenged three wide entering the second turn but tired late. DARING DIVA reserved early, made a good middle move three wide but had no late bid. TIJUANA BRASS vied for the lead along the inside, held on well to the furlong marker and tired. SELASSIE alternated for the lead off the inside and faded in the stretch.
