FRISKY MOOD closest to the pace four wide, made a run at the leader in upper stretch and drew clear under steady urging. DRIPDRY forwardly placed off the rail, angled out six wide leaving the turn and finished willingly to be up for the place. MISSY GIRL outsprinted early, raced four wide on the turn, angled wider entering the stretch and made a solid late bid. SPECTACULAR MORGAN sprinted clear, set the pace in the three path and tired late. OUR MAJESTIC QUEEN within striking distance five wide, lacked a late bid. FANCY MAMA forwardly placed four wide, had nothing left late. SAVE THE COINS outrun early, raced six wide late on the turn and was no threat. GO LAUREN bobbled after the start and was no threat. PRIVATE GAMBLE reserved off the inside, tired. THEWRIGHTWAY was outrun. SEE YA IN INDY was no factor. I AM ALPHABET SOUP trailed.
