Footnotes

EYEOFHEHURRICANE closest to the pace, raced four wide on the turn, challenged in midstretch and proved narrowly best. SILENT STREET close up outside, advanced five wide on the turn, gained a short lead with a furlong to go but was outfinished. THE LUCKIEST bobbed after breaking in the air, was outrun early, made a bold six wide run on the turn to reach a forward position but hung late. EVEN TEMPO reserved early, stayed in the five path on the turn and finished well late. HOUSEBOAT close up from the start, saved ground on the turn and tired in the final furlong. BELLICOSE steadied near the half mile marker, recovered to be close up three wide but lacked a late bid. STELLAS NEW GROOVE outrun for a half, lodged a mild late bid. BRIDLED PATH set the pace off the inside and gave way in the final furlong. COUNTMEASAFRIEND outrun early, raced in the five path on the turn and was too late. IM CLASSIC QUALITY six wide on the turn, could not menace. BEPPIN tired while off the inside. KAREN'S IDOL had speed for a half.
