FOR MONEY close up along the inside, challenged from the rail on the turn and drew clear under steady urging. HONCHO'S HONEY set the pace off the inside, responded willingly when challenged on the turn but tired late. KIRBY'S CARR forwardly placed three wide, lacked the needed late bid. FAIRY DUST never far back in the four path, tired. SURE NUFF within striking distance along the inside, steadied approaching the stretch when in tight, angled out in upper stretch but could not threaten. HASTA MAS TARDE never far back while off the inside, faded. POLLY T. was outrun.
