Footnotes

SIR P. T. CHALONE broke slow, settled saving ground, angled out five wide on the second turn, and was fully extended to narrowly prevail. MAJOR WINTERS contended off of the inside, got through to make his bid, kept on well but wasn't quite good enough. WICKLOW COUNTY was allowed to settle, circled six wide, loomed large entering the stretch, but bumped with GRAND PIANO MAN through the drive and lacked the needed late response. GRAND PIANO MAN was allowed to settle, came five wide between horses, but bumped with WICKLOW COUNTY in the drive and flattened. JEFF'S KITTEN was unhurried into stride, finished with a belated gain and improved position. GHOST TIME disputed the pace three wide to the stretch and faded. POPULAR CAUSE set the pressured pace along the inside, was headed entering the stretch and gave way readily. EASY TO REMEMBER was close up four wide for six furlongs and tired. BARON SLEW failed to respond. IT'S ALL ABOUT JOY showed little. TASTEFORCHAMPAGNE was never a factor. JUSTAMATTEROFTIME was through early.
