Footnotes

WON HAPPY BACHELOR outrun for a half, advanced inside on the second turn, angled out for the drive and closed fast to be clear. BUDDHA CAN DANCE closest to the early pace inside, challenged after six furlongs, drew clear in midstretch but was outfinished. KING KIRK outrun early, made a good inside middle move but lodged only a mild late bid. WAKES WEEK forwardly placed, raced in the four path on the second turn and tired in the drive. CRIMSON CLAY six wide with three furlongs to go, could not threaten. CAME TO SCORE reserved four wide, moved a bit wider with three furlongs to go and was no factor. JACOB'S TIGER sprinted clear and angled in, set the pace to the stretch and tired. SAHM VALENTINE failed to menace. MOVE ON UP forwardly placed between rivals, stopped.
