WEKIVA'S ILEAN settled in hand, ranged up four wide through the bend, came to level terms entering the stretch, shook off her rivals and edged clear through the final furlong. LITTLE B'S ANGEL set the pressured pace along the inside, was unable to match strides with the winner but stayed on well to hold the place. CALL HER GRIMACE pressed the pace three wide, but weakened between rivals in the drive and gave way. CINDY ANDY was slow into stride, circled five wide to make a mild rally but failed to threaten. WERBLIN'S CHANCE was unhurried early, came four wide and finished with a belated gain. DARE RIDGE contended between horses, steadied from tight quarters near the seven-sixteenths pole and went evenly thereafter. SQUEAKIN BYE saved ground to little avail. FEELIN THE SHOCK was close up four wide, but stopped before going three furlongs.
