BROKEN TANGO settled in hand, ranged up four wide through the turn, poked his head in front with a furlong to run and prove narrowly best. TIBAN rushed to the lead along the inside, fought on well through a long drive but was unable to resist the winner. HOTNITESINMICHIGAN disputed the pace three wide to the stretch and gave way. ROCKY BEAR was unhurried into stride, moved up five wide on the turn, angled in entering the stretch and improved position. CHASE ME FOREVER was allowed to settle in mid pack and failed to respond. BIG BLUE FEVER passed only the tiring ones. CITY SEEKER prompted the pace between horses for a half and dropped out. AWESOMECHRISTOPHER was through early.
