LANGLEY PARK settled in hand four wide, took closer order after a half, drew even leaving the second turn and proved best following a stiff drive. MODEL'S MEMO attended the pace along the inside, got through to make a bold bid, forged command with a furlong to run but was unable to match strides late. ALIVILA opened clear to set the pace, was collared between rivals with a quarter to run, gave way and settled for the show. KENTUCKY KITTY contended along the inside but lacked the needed late response. COMMADORE KATE was allowed to settle three wide, tipped out five wide entering the stretch but failed to respond when asked. BIG SIS AND TWINS was never a factor. JEB'S FRIEND contended along the inside, was shuffled back from tight quarter after a half and came up empty thereafter. BERRY DELIGHTFUL was outrun.
