PRAIRIE PRIZE pressed the pace along the inside, forged command with a quarter to run, shook clear entering the stretch and maintained a safe advantage. REACHFORTHECASTLE stalked the pace four wide, launched her bid leaving the turn, was unable to reach the winner but clearly proved second best. MISSING SEFA was unhurried into stride, split horses to launch a bold bid entering the lane but lacked the needed late response. EVEN ALY settled in hand, angled out to be clear, came six wide but failed to respond when asked. MUD CREEK passed only her tiring rivals. INSTALL set the pressured pace three wide, was headed after a half and tired from between horses entering the stretch. BREAK NEW GROUND rushed to contention along the inside, checked from tight quarters with three furlongs to run and showed little thereafter.
