STRATEGIC DECISION vied for the lead off the inside, responded when challenged by the runner up in upper stretch and edged off late. ACHIEVABLE in hand along the inside behind the leaders, moved off the rail, reached closest to the winner on the second turn, made an earnest challenge once in the stretch, could not stay late but was clearly second best. BIRMAN within striking distance four wide, moved out a path for the second turn, held on well to the stretch and tired. SWINGING BERNIE close up five wide, moved in a path on the second turn and faded in the stretch. PIPER'S FRIEND alternated for the lead along the inside and stopped. NAVAJO PARK was no threat.
