STEW BOY broke awkwardly, moved up between horses, was hemmed in leaving the second turn, bulled through rivals entering the stretch, forged command and edged clear. ERIC'S KITTEN settled in hand three wide, shifted out five wide to make his bid but was unable to reach the winner. THOMAS IS ROCKIN set the pressured pace along the inside, was headed nearing the furlong marker, weakened but had enough left to hold the show. PRINCINI pressed the pace two wide, was forced wide leaving the second turn and gave way. MICHAELS PARK contended five wide to the stretch and tired. R FAST CAT made a middle move six wide but came up empty before going six furlongs and faded. MIDNIGHT LEGACY saved ground to no avail. RATHER QUICK was through after a half.
