GRIPEY SARAH disputed the pace along the inside, drifted out leaving the turn, came four wide, opened clear and maintained a safe advantage. IMAGE OF GRACE vied for the lead three wide, was carried out further leaving the turn, was unable to match strides with the winner but stayed on well to just hold the place. APP FOR THAT hopped at the start and was off slow, rushed to contention along the inside, got through entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. SUNSHINE CRUISE made a middle move five wide to offer a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. QUEEN OF SCIOTO pressed the pace between horses, weakened before going a half and finished evenly. HILLARY'S HARBOR angled in to save ground and failed to threaten. TELMA passed the tiring ones. COUNT OLAF contended between horses for a half and retreated. K C LEE was six wide and through early.
