YOUNITY within striking distance, advanced three wide late on the turn and closed well to be clear late. KEEP THIS CAT vied for the lead four wide, angled in in upper stretch and held on gamely. U GOT THE TOUCH behind the leaders, challenged from the five path midway through the turn but weakened late. CLEVER MAID forced the pace off the inside and tired. STORMY TERMS pressed the pace from the inside, steadied near the three furlong marker when in tight then was no threat. RED HOT AFFAIR outrun early, could not menace. DANCING HING reserved early, swerved out eight wide around RIDE NOW late on the turn and was no factor. RIDE NOW forced the pace three wide between rivals , steadied after dropping back midway through the turn, drifted wide approaching the stretch and faded.
