SMARTER THAN EVER set the pace off the inside and increased his lead late under steady urging. UNBRIDLED MAKER forced the pace outside the winner, was no match for that one late but held on for the place. KATHERN'S JEWEL stumbled at the start, was reserved early five wide, stayed in that path on the second turn and lacked a late bid. COURTEOUS INTENT within reach early three wide, worked his way in on the second turn but tired in the stretch along the inside. RIP AND ROLL close up along the inside, raced off the rail on the second turn, stayed on well to the final furlong and tired. KNOWS HOW TO ROCK outrun early along the inside, failed to threaten. ROAD TO THE RING forwardly placed four wide, moved out to be six wide with three furlongs to go and gave way. BIG BLUE FEVER six wide on the first turn, was no factor. CAMPTON prominent early four wide, faded. SIR RUDY was no factor. EYE FOR AN EYE was through early. ARSHAVIN was outrun.
