**Footnotes**

GOOD BUT WICKED close up three wide, responded in the stretch and finished willingly to be up late. D. C. GENE within striking distance, moved up in that path on the second turn to challenged, assumed a short lead with a furlong to go but was outfinished. SPLURGING alternated for the lead off the inside, battled into the final furlong and tired late. AUTUMN STAR within striking distance off the rail, steadied along the inside near the five-sixteenth marker, angled out four wide entering the stretch but hung. B MAN outrun along the inside, made a good three wide middle move but could not sustain the bid. SUN VALLEY AL steadied along the inside on the first turn, took up entering the second turn then faded in the drive. MADE FOR A MISSION reserved five wide, raced in the four path on the second turn and was no threat. ALLEY CAT GANG alternated for the lead along the inside, and stopped. WHITE PRINCE four wide with three furlongs to go, was no factor. CASTLE STORM was outrun.
