LUCKY KITTEN within striking distance four wide, challenged from that path on the second turn and proved narrowly best in a long drive. UNSTOPPABLE U pressed the pace three wide, responded willingly on the second turn after gaining a short lead, battled the winner the remainder but missed. IMPASSABLE CANYON within reach from the start, moved out a path for the second turn and lacked the needed closing bid. STARFORCE close up along the inside, moved off the rail near the three furlong marker, held on well to the final furlong and tired. PAROLED reared at the start, bobbed breaking, was outrun five wide, moved in a bit with three furlongs to go and could not threaten. EXULTANT set the pace along the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired.
