TRU ATTITUDE outrun early, advanced five wide into the turn, continued that run four wide into the stretch and finished well to be clear late. PENNYROYAL vied for the early lead between rivals, gained the inside midway through the turn, drew clear in midstretch and held on gamely. WISE AFFAIR forced the pace from the rail, dropped back a bit midway through the turn when in tight, came off the rail for the drive but went evenly late. QUICK ADVICE within striking distance along the inside, lacked the needed closing bid. DEVINE FORCE behind the leaders in the four path, had little left late. FOOLISH TEE forced the pace three wide, held on well to midstretch and weakened. IMPERIAL GRACE was no threat. STAR CREST five wide into the turn, was no real threat.
