SULTRY BIDDER vied for the early lead three wide, took over before a half, set the pace off the rail around the second turn, increased his lead into the stretch and lasted late. GAMBLER'S HONOUR outrun early, advanced in the three path on the second turn, angled out for the drive and closed fast late. SULTRY PLEASURE forwardly placed along the inside, angled out to be four wide on the second turn and lodged only a mild late bid. STORM COVER within striking distance four wide, made a good five wide middle move but could not sustain the bid. SLEW'S SUMMIT six wide on the first turn when outrun, stayed in that path on the second turn and could not threaten. ROARIN' LAUREN reserved off the rail, gave way the final quarter. MAKER'S AND GINGER contested the early pace off the inside and faded. ZAMBLES was no factor.
