OTANER stalked the pace four wide, launched his bid entering the stretch and was fully extended to wear down SWAYLON BRAYLON in the final strides. SWAYLON BRAYLON was bumped at the start, opened clear to set the pace, continued on willingly through a prolonged drive but was unable to resist the winner. GOOB was unhurried into stride, swung seven wide and was just up to earn the show. COWCUTTA contended between horses, but flattened in the final furlong and gave way. HUSTLE HARD was close up off of the inside, but faltered leaving the turn and faded. TOTHEMOONANDBEYOND broke slow and bobbled at the start, settled off of the inside but lacked a response when called upon. CHAZZY HUSTLE saved ground to no avail. GATEWOOD broke inwardly and bumped SWAYLON BRAYLON and showed little thereafter. The jockey of TOTHEMOONANDBEYOND lodged an objection against SWAYLON BRAYLON for alleged interference leaving the gate, but following the review the Stewards made no change to the order of finish.
