TRICKLE DOWN reserved early near the rail, advanced off the inside into the stretch, moved to the rail in midstretch and finished fast to win going away. GOLDEN SLIVER vied for the lead off the inside, took over on the turn but was no match for the winner late. JUST WHAT I NEED within striking distance off the inside, rallied willingly late. BABY ALICE unhurried early, made a four wide move on the turn but lodged only a mild late bid. SPONTANEOUS never far back, moved between rivals on the turn to reach closest to the pace but lacked a late bid. SALT LAKES AP PHIRE unhurried early, was off the inside on the turn and was no factor. GO YOUR OWN WAY outrun early, was four wide on the turn and was no threat. MY BABY GIRL vied for the lead, gained the inside on the turn and faded. JEALOUS AND JADED never far back in the three path, faded. MAGIC TOUCH fractious in the gate, raced within striking distance along the inside and stopped. REGINA ROSE outrun early, raced five wide into the turn and stopped.
