MISS MULIE close up along the inside, angled out approaching the stretch, drifted in near the sixteenth marker when challenging the leader then drew clear late. LOUEY VILL forwardly placed three wide, challenged after a half, took over on the second turn, steadied when the winner drifted in to her near the sixteenth marker then held the place. ANNOUNCE OF CHARM never far back three wide, lacked the needed late bid. REAL STUFF outrun for a half, came six wide late on the second turn and improved her position while no threat. SCOTLAND PLACE outrun early, raced four wide into the stretch and had little left late. LIGHT ON HER TOES reserved early, was no threat. VALENTINE FLING vied for the lead off the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. JEWEL OF A GAL could not menace. MALIGN was no factor. ALY'S OPEN was outrun. CLIPPER CAT forced the pace from the inside, came off the rail for the drive, drifted in with a furlong to go and faded. OATSVILLE within striking distance inside, steadied along the rail with a furlong to go and gave way.
