MAGICAL COURT forwardly placed five wide, challenged with a furlong to go and drew clear under steady urging. DON'TGETMADGETEVEN alternated for the lead in the four path and held on for the place. NEED MONEY DAD within striking distance three wide, angled out for the drive and made a late bid. CUNNINGHAM forced the pace three wide, held on well to midstretch and tired. TWO SEAT PETE in tight after the start, recovered to race within striking distance five wide but lacked the needed closing bid. CITIZEN JOHN pressed the pace off the inside and tired. DARE HE GOES was outrun. GETALONG outrun early, raced six wide on the turn and could not threaten. OUR TWO close up along the inside, faded.
