DANCING DON stalked the pace in hand, launched a sweeping move four wide, assumed command leaving the second turn and drew away to score as the rider pleased. INDY RIDE settled saving ground, got through entering the stretch and was along in time to earn the place. FOREVER SURE pressed the pace along the inside, was no match for the winner, continued on fairly well and just missed preserving the place. CORNWHISKEY settled between horses, finished with a mild rally three wide but failed to seriously threaten. ALFRIE'S FRIENDS passed only the tiring ones. JEFF THE CLOCKER was hustled along three wide to attend the pace, but came up empty after six furlongs and faded. OUR KING set the pressured pace three wide, was collared between horses on the second turn and gave way readily once headed. MONASHEE GOLD (IRE) showed little in a dull effort.
