JO JO JUICE prompted the pace along the inside, settled off of the lead on the turn, angled out entering the stretch, came again and edged clear late. HAYLEY'S BAYLEY set the pressured pace between horses, fought on through a prolonged drive but grudgingly gave in. HERE COMES DESSERT settled saving ground, got through and was along in time to earn the show. UNDER SERVED made a middle move four wide, offered a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. LOVIN SABRINA was unhurried into stride, finished with a belated gain but failed to threaten. CLEOTA pressed the pace three wide to the stretch and faltered. HALF MOON BEAUTY showed little. PRINCESS FREEDOM was outrun.
