PRINCE TETON vied for the lead off the rail, dropped back a bit after a half, came again between rivals late on the second turn to challenge and edged clear late. DOUBLEFOUR reserved three wide, moved out a path with three furlongs to go, maintained position into the stretch then made a late bid for the place. JEMARU lost his footing at the start, was reserved for a half, made a good four wide move thereafter, challenged approaching the stretch but weakened. CASE CLOCKER alternated for the lead three wide, came in a path on the second turn, held on well to the final furlong and tired late. BROTHER STUART within striking distance along the inside, lacked a rally. OUT DRINKIN' bobbled a bit at the start, was outrun early, was wide on the second turn and never threatened. CANYON COPPER behind the leaders, raced three wide on the second turn and faded.
