ENDLESSLY set the pace along the inside while under light restraint, responded willingly when asked to pick up her pace a bit entering the stretch and drew off under intermittent urging. UPON A THRON within striking distance early four wide, maintained position three wide on the second turn then lodged a mild late bid to be up for the place. DANZIG MATILDA outrun early four wide, improved her position off the rail on the second turn but finished evenly in the final furlong. SOUTHERN TAPESTRY four wide on the first turn gaining position, pressed the pace outside the winner, held well to the stretch and tired. MISS BARBARA was close up off the inside, saved ground on the second turn and gave way. NANCYBDANCING stumbled at the start, made a quick recovery to be within striking distance three wide but tired. CLASS steadied entering the first turn when in tight, was outrun along the inside and was no factor. PRUDIE five wide on the first ;turn when a forward factor, stayed well to the stretch and faded.
