FLIGHT outrun early, advanced inside on the turn and closed well to be clear. NEW PAIS within striking distance, raced six wide on the turn and closed well for the place. THUNDER HIGHWAY reserved early, raced in the three path on the turn and lodged a mild late bid. CARSON'S PRIDE forwardly placed from the start, raced five wide with three furlongs to go, maintained good position to the stretch but lacked a late bid. WISE DAN close up along the inside, challenged on the turn, drew clear into the stretch but faltered late. MOUNT DOLLBERG five wide on the turn, lodged a mild late bid. SUN BEAR lot his footing a bit at the start, was outrun early, raced six wide out of the turn and made a late gain. SIR SMART within striking distance three wide, tired. RIGALI NATION set the pace off the inside and tired in the drive. PLUTONIUM close up four wide, gave way. DRAKE MANOR never menaced.
