ENDLESS HONOUR vied for the lead from the outset, raced three wide into the turn, took over approaching the stretch and drew off under steady urging. MISS MARKER outrun early off the inside, angled out in upper stretch and finished well. HOOTIES GAMBLE forced the pace outside, was four wide entering the turn and tired in the drive. LITTLE RED CRIMSON outrun early while in the three path, was no threat. LET SALT FLY within striking distance, was five wide with three furlongs to go and gave way in the stretch. AND THATS MY STORY forced the pace between rivals, gained the inside on the turn and faded in the drive. RICH SILK within striking distance along the inside, faded. SODA POP TOP prompted the pace from the inside and stopped.
