DARBY'S CHARM vied for the lead along the inside, was no match for the winner but held on for the place. MINISTER LADY alternated for the lead off the inside and tired late. BETIDO broke in the air, recovered to race within striking distance while off the rail but lacked a closing bid. AFTERNOON DREAMS outsprinted off the rail, was no threat. SILKY SUMMER was outrun. AUNT CONNIE five wide into the turn, faded. MONASTIC behind the leaders three wide, broke down.
