SILVER OWL sprinted clear, set the pace along the inside, repulsed bids by ONE TOUGH CAT and UNBRIDLES APPROVAL at the quarter pole, drew clear then held sway late. ONE TOUGH CAT forwardly placed three wide, moved to challenge three wide approaching the stretch, dropped back a bit in upper stretch then came again late. UNBRIDLED APPROVAL closest to the pace off the inside, challenged between rivals approaching the stretch but weakened in the drive. PROSPECTOR RUNNING outrun early along the inside, raced off the rail on the second turn and rallied belatedly. LEGENDARY PEACH five wide early when within striking distance, angled in a bit but tired. TENDER TOUCH reserved early, was no real threat. WHAT A FILLY LES outrun early, raced four wide late on the second turn and was no factor. WICKETTE four wide early, faded.
