PROCEED BEE close up three wide, angled out and moved up five wide on the second turn, challenged midway through that turn and edged clear late under pressure. PARADE CLOWN five wide on the first turn when within striking distance, angled in a bit on the backstretch, gained a short lead in the three path on the second turn, responded willingly when displaced in midstretch and held on gamely. TOCCET ROCKET outrun off the inside, moved out to the four path on the second turn when rallying but lodged only a mild late bid. SHANES GOLD within striking distance in the four path, challenged four wide on the seconds turn, held on well to the final furlong and tired. STRATOS squeezed at the start, recovered to race within striking distance, raced three wide on the second turn and could not menace. DYNAMITE BOB lost his footing a bit at the start, recovered quickly, vied for the lead inside, came off the rail for the second turn, held on well to the stretch and tired. PLATINUM VAN bobbled at the start, alternated for the lead off the inside and stopped.
