HI HO EURO set the pace off the inside, drew off into the stretch and stayed clear while kept to the task. TOP VALUE far back early, settled late on the turn and closed well late. MOREKISSESFORPATTI reserved early, moved out six wide approaching the stretch and made a late gain. TALKIN AND SINGING within striking distance off the rail, moved to the inside with a quarter mile to go but lodged only a mild late bid. INVITATION was no threat. CLIFFTY'S DYNAGIRL far back to the stretch, found her best stride too late. PLEASANT SPRING could not menace. FLAMETTE closest to the pace three wide, faded. BULL ALLEY forwardly placed off the inside, gave way. HUGGLE BUBBLE prominent four wide, stopped. KITTS FITZ was through after a half.
