Footnotes

CHAMPALI close up early four wide, challenged from the outside before a half, took over midway through the second turn, increased his lead into the stretch, repulsed a bid by CHICKEN SOUP KID nearing the sixteenth marker and quickly drew off late. CHICKEN SOUP KID bumped FALSE PROMISES at the start, recovered to race within striking distance inside, dropped back a bit before a half, advanced four wide on the second turn, reached near even terms with the winner inside the final furlong but was no match for that one late. GREY COMET vied for the early lead along the inside, moved off the rail on the backstretch, continued well to the quarter mile marker, angled out once in the stretch and tired. HONEAGLE angled in early, raced within striking distance along the inside, moved a bit closer approaching the stretch but tired in the final furlong. WENDLAR outrun early, made a run along the inside after a half, was in close quarters entering the stretch, was in tight along the rail near the furlong marker, angled out and lacked a late bid. PAULA'S PRIDE forwardly placed three wide, held on well to the stretch and gave way. TITO'S BEAU bumped FALSE PROMISES at the start, was outrun early and was no factor. FALSE PROMISES bothered at the start, was reserved early inside and was no threat. LX COMMANDER vied for the lead off the inside, was in tight near the three furlong marker then stopped.
