BLUE CHERRIES SPIN set the pressured pace three deep, shook clear entering the stretch, was kept to task and increased his advantage. SMOKEY THE BANDIT settled saving ground, split rivals to launch his bid, failed to threaten the winner but continued on willingly to earn the place. MIRRORED prompted the pace between horses, dropped back through the turn, angled out and came again with a mild bid but lacked the needed late response. BRIGHT SPARK vied for the lead along the inside, but weakened during the drive and gave way. ALL TIZ came five wide to make a mild bid with a quarter to run but failed to sustain the drive. CAPE HATTERAS was slow into stride, bore out through the turn, was taken up and eased to the wire but walked off.
