MR. LATONIA stalked the pace, launched his bid four wide, and was fully extended to wear down the determined COWCUTTA in the final strides. COWCUTTA set the pressured pace toward the inside, fought gamely but grudgingly gave way. ARCTIC POINT made a long drive six wide, kept on well but settled for the minor award. PASTOR PUCKETT was unhurried into stride, circled seven wide and improved position. SGT MAJOR SCHLOSKEY contended between horses, but flattened between horses leaving the turn and faded. FITZ IS DANCING was allowed to settle, finished with a belated gain but failed to threaten. MCKEANS BOY exchanged bumps early, contended along the inside, but came up empty after a half and faded. LITTLE CAPE TOWN exchanged bumps early, was close up between horses, but was through after a half and dropped out. SHELLBARK was through early.
