JUNE MONSOON set the pressured pace three wide, opened clear on the turn, widened entering the stretch, was kept to task and held safely. P. V. PARK stalked the pace, came four wide to make her bid, but was unable to reach the winner. SAQQARAH was allowed to settle, came five wide and was just up to earn the show. HARE PRIZE contended along the inside, shifted out between horses leaving the turn, got through entering the stretch but flattened in the drive and ended in a three wide dead heat for the fourth spot. MORGANSMOONSHINE was allowed to settle, mounted a late rally between horses and was part of the trio knotted to complete the superfecta. JUST SHUT UP was unhurried into stride, came four wide but went evenly through the final furlong and ended on even terms with HARE PRIZE and MORGANMOONSHINE for fourth. MIST IN THE MORN was hung wide and was never a factor. IRMA LA DUCE (FR) vied for the lead along the inside, but stopped before going a half.
