PLEASE US, forwardly placed off the inside, challenged with a furlong to go and edged off late under pressure. TRICKLE DOWN, within striking distance early in the three path, rallied well on the outside in the final furlong. LEAHA, closest to the pace, took over along the inside on the turn and held on gamely in the drive. SUNSHINE AGAIN, unhurried early, saved ground on the turn but was no threat. SALEM EMPRESS, reserved early, raced four wide on the turn and tired. RANBA set the early pace off the inside and gave way in the drive. WITCHY DORS broke slow and was outrun.
