Footnotes

DUBIOUS MISS five wide on the first turn when within striking distance, challenged from that path on the second turn, took over in midstretch and lasted late. WHAT A CHARACTER unhurried off the inside advanced four wide late on the second turn, came wider for the drive and rallied willingly. TRUST YOUR LUCK unhurried four wide, advanced five wide on the second turn, reached closest to the winner with a furlong to go but lodged only a mild late bid. CHESTERMITE forwardly placed four wide, challenged on the second turn, stayed on well to the final furlong and tired. CITYBOY OR COWBOY within striking distance, saved ground into the second turn, angled out a bit but had little left late. ALYDAR'S CAUSEWAY reserved early three wide, made a solid middle move but had no late bid. GALLANT AGAIN pressed the pace three wide and tired. PRIZED LEADER was outrun. MANCINI'S MAN set a pressured pace and stopped. ORLANDEL forced the pace off the inside and stopped.
