After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing 6th through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes at a mile or over allowed, 2lbs.; A Sweepstakes, 4 lbs.; two races other than maiden or claiming at a mile or over, 6 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve starters. Footnotes

STATE OF PLAY prompted the pace three wide, settled off of the leader on the backstretch, tucked to the inside of ILL CONCEIVED near the three furlong marker, poked his head in front midway through the second turn, fought on determinedly and was fully extended to prevail. ILL CONCEIVED set the pressured pace off of the inside, drifted out further on the backstretch, opened clear after a half, was headed near the five-sixteenths pole, battled on gamely but just missed in a grand effort. DYNAMICAL attended the pace along the inside under a hard hold, tipped out four wide entering the stretch, loomed a danger but failed to make headway through the lane. MR. PRANKSTER was allowed to settle, circled five wide but lacked a response when called upon. POSEY ROSE was rank to place through the first turn, had the saddle slip nearing the three-quarter pole, leveled into stride at the tail of the field, showed little thereafter, was taken up entering the stretch, eased to the wire but walked off.
