CAUGHT ME LOOKING settled in hand, ranged up five wide through the second turn, forged command with three-sixteenths to run and widened. TIZ FRIDAY tracked the pace four wide, bid between rivals near the quarter pole, bit was unable to match strides with the winner. CEEBETT'S SOUL contested the issue toward the inside, weakened during the drive but had enough left to hold the show. CHINCHILLA DAY was pinched back at the start, was allowed to settle, moved up between horses to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. OUTOFSITEOUTOFMIND prompted the pace three wide, but faltered between horses entering the stretch and faded. LEAD PLAYER was bumped and jostled between horses at the start, was unhurried into stride and passed only the tiring ones. GOVERNMENT ROAD was forwardly placed along the inside for six furlongs and retreated. MY CHAPERREL was bumped at the start and was never a factor. FREE SHIPPING saved ground to no avail. ONE FOR DUMAANI broke inward bumping LEAD PLAYER and was outrun.
