Footnotes

SULTRY PLEASURE settled in hand while never far back four deep, circled five wide to range into striking distance through the second turn, then was fully extended to wear down YULLAH in the final strides. The latter was away alertly and set the pressured pace along the inside, edged clear leaving the second turn, kept on well through a prolonged drive but was turned away in the shadow of the wire. GETALONG lunged at the start, pulled to contention four wide, loomed a danger nearing the quarter pole, but weakened during the drive and settled for a minor award. GERI'S KID broke in the air, was unhurried into stride, closed the gap through the second turn, angled out entering the stretch and improved his position. UNSUNG HERO veered out at the start and was slow into stride, settled at the tail of the field well back, swung five wide to make a belated gain but was never a factor. LAST TRAM was forwardly placed along the inside to the stretch and retreated. CORTONA'S QUEST pressed the pace three wide, but was used up before going six furlongs and dropped out.
