WILL E SCAT settled between rivals, split horses entering the stretch, quickened and was up in the final strides. MR. NONAME stalked the pace three wide, forged command and opened clear with a furlong to run, continued on well but wasn't quite good enough. SUNBURST hopped at the start, was rank to place, angled out and made a bold bid five wide but lacked the needed late response. LORD AND T. was hustled along between horses, came six wide and improved position. I'VE HEARD IT ALL dueled for the lead two wide, but weakened in the final furlong and faded. ROYAL ENSIGN settled toward the inside, shifted out and finished with a belated gain. NEW YORK BOBBY was hung wide throughout and failed to respond. SEAVIEW dueled for the lead along the inside to the stretch and stopped.
