ALPHALPHA vied for the lead near the rail, drew clear in midstretch and lasted late. PERFECT TRIP hit the side of the starting gate stall at the start then bobbed, was outrun early, angled out late on the turn when rallying then closed well late. NATIVEMAN forced the pace off the inside, held on well to the final furlong and tired. THE RAG MAN forwardly placed three wide, tired. DRAKE MANOR close up along the inside, gave way in the drive. IRON ROD within striking distance, raced four wide with three furlongs to go and tired. OUR REGARDS was outrun.
