Footnotes

CHOCOLATE BLISS set the pressured pace off of the inside, brushed with PRINCESS KUMA entering the stretch, repulsed the challenge from that one and gamely kicked clear. TIME FOR DUBAI settled in hand, ranged up four wide through the second turn, loomed a danger entering the stretch but flattened during the drive. PRINCESS KUMA tucked to the rail entering the first turn, prompted the pace to the inside of CHOCOLATE BLISS thereafter, got through and brushed with the winner entering the stretch, drew to level terms with three-sixteenths to run, but weakened during the drive. ASIAN JOY stalked the pace three wide, moved up to engage the leaders between horses, but faltered entering the stretch and faded. GOT NO ANSWERS was allowed to settle and lacked a response when called upon. RADICAL MEASURES was unhurried five wide and was never a factor. The trainer of PRINCESS KUMA lodged an objection against CHOCOLATE BLISS alleging interference at the head of the lane, but following the Stewards review there was no change to the order of finish.
