NEEDADRINK close up from the start, challenged three wide on the turn, dropped back a bit into the stretch then made a late bid to be up for the place. MISS ELIZA within striking distance off the inside, lodged a mild rally. SONJA'S ANGEL forced the pace off the inside, held on well to the final furlong and tired late. MAD ABOUT SUE was no threat while three wide. PRAIRIE PRIZE vied for the lead along the inside, held on well to the stretch and gave way. PORTEND close up along the inside, faded.
