CHALONE hesitated at the start and was away well behind his field, made a long drive circling six wide and finished well to earn the place. JO THE CAT made a middle move four wide, offered a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. REBELS ROOST was allowed to settle, made a mild rally between rivals but failed to seriously threaten. SIR RUDY was hustled along five wide for a half and tired. GRACE'S DEVIL was forwardly placed along the inside to the stretch and faded. CHARLIE'S RAINMAN passed the tiring ones. MILKY MAY chased the pace three wide for a half and retreated. CUT MAN was through early. ROB'S ROCK saved ground to no avail.
